

ICV and MAPH visited earthquake places in Turkey

Last week, Peter Bhatti, Chairman of International Christian Voice (ICV) and Dr. Gezahn Wordofa, President and founder of Multicultural Association of Perth Huron (MAPH), along with their teams visited two cities of Turkey Hatay and Antakya where more than 50,000 people have been killed and 1.5 million people have been displaced following a devastating earthquake earlier this year.

The purpose of their visit was to survey the damage in the aftermath of the earthquake, provide humanitarian support to the victims, and provide recommendations to the Canadian government on the aid requirements in the region. They will also be providing direct assistance to the most affected individuals and families through support with their migration to Canada.

MAPH and ICV are confident that Canadians will respond to the needs of the victims with kindness and generosity to ensure that they are able to rebuild their livelihoods and have hope for their futures. They will also be working closely with the Canadian government to ensure that the recommendations provided are heard and acted upon to create a permanent solution for those affected by this devastating event.
